

## Rules & Conditions of Entry

- Competitions are run in accordance with the BSJA rules
  - All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over
  - No entry will be refunded after the closing date except on production of a medical or veterinary certificate
  - The judge's decision is final and any objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and accompanied by a £15.00 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
  - It is the condition that no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers, their representatives or helpers for any loss or damage to spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends or property under any circumstances whatsoever
  - Bookham Riding Club reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without disclosing a reason or to alter, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary
  - It is the responsibility of all competitors to present themselves in time for the classes in which they are entered
  - Horses must NOT be left tied to vehicles and left unattended
  - All dogs *must* be kept on a lead on the show ground at all times
  - NO BICYCLES to be ridden on showground
  - Prize money and/or rosettes may be withheld if there are insufficient entries in a class
  - Protective headgear, properly secured must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SNZ3838 1998. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk.. All competitors must wear correct riding dress. Body protectors are recommended
  - It is the responsibility of all participants to clear up their rubbish and debris and leave the showground fit for grazing. *Please* do not muck our your horsebox/trailer on the showground
- The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.

### Qualification & Restrictions

Show Jumping: 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> qualify in selected classes: 1'6"/45cm, 1'9"/50cm, 2'60cm, 2'3"/70cm, 2'6"/75cm, 2'9"/85cm, 3'90cm and 3'3"/1m. Restriction: Neither horse/pony nor rider to have won more than £99 BSJA prize money or any BE points.

Showing: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> qualify in selected classes of In-hand, Lead Rein, Ridden Showing and Working Hunter/Pony. Restriction: Neither horse/pony or rider can be members of any affiliated national showing organisation.

**If you qualify you'll receive a Sunshine Tour qualification card – simply fill in and return or register online for an information pack and details of how to enter the Sunshine Tour Championship at Great Bookham Equestrian Centre on 25 & 26 September 2010.**

Entry Fee £5 BRC members, £8 Non members

**Class 1** Mini Jumping 2'0 horse/pony not to have won more than £30

**Class 2** Minimus Jumping 2'3 horse/pony not to have won more than £40 -**Qualifier for Sunshine Tour 2010**

**Class 3** Novice Jumping 2'6 horse/pony not to have won more than £75. All Bookham Riding Club members placed or jumping a double clear qualify for the Championship on 10 October.

**Will not start before 13:00 hrs**

**Class 4** Intermediate Jumping 2'9 Horse/pony must not be currently competing in BSJA competitions.

**Class 5** Open Jumping 3'0-3'3 - **Qualifier for Sunshine Tour 2010**

## RING 2

### 9.30am – 12 noon Clear round Jumping

Jumps will be raised in accordance with Ring 1.  
£3 per round or 2 for £5

**Will not start before 12.30pm**

**Class 6** Working Hunter. Jumps approx 2'3 – 2'6. **Qualifier for Sunshine Tour 2010**

**Class 7** Ridden Show Hunter. 15.2hh and over

**Class 8** Riding Horse

**Class 9** Pony Club Pony / Riding Club Horse. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle and will be required to jump approx 2'3. **Qualifier for Sunshine Tour 2010**

**Ridden Horse Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 6 - 9**

**Class 14** In-hand Veteran. Horses/ponies over 16 years of age

**Class 15** In-hand Mountain and Moorland – pure and part bred

**In-hand Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 10 – 15**

**Will not start before 1pm**

Entry Fee £5 BRC members, £8 Non members

**Class 16** Ridden Coloured. A) piebald, skewbald B) palomino, dun, spotted, roan

**Class 17** Ridden Cob

**Class 18** Ridden Mountain and Moorland (full/part breeds)

**Class 19** Ridden Veteran. Horses/ponies over 15 years of age. **Qualifier for Veteran Horse Society.** Sec A) Pre-veteran 15-19 years Sec B) Veteran 20-24 years Sec C) Veteran Plus 25 years & over

**Ridden Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 16 - 19**
