### Qualification & Restrictions

Dressage: 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> qualify in selected Walk & Trot, Prelim, Novice and Elementary classes. Restriction: for W&T and Prelim championship neither horse/pony nor rider to have earned any British Dressage points, for Novice champs not more than 20 BD points and for Elementary not more than 40 points.

**If you qualify you'll receive a Sunshine Tour qualification card – simply fill in and return or register online for an information pack and details of how to enter the Sunshine Tour Championship at Great Bookham Equestrian Centre on 25 & 26 September 2010.**

Directions to the club field: From Leatherhead, take the A245 Leatherhead Road signposted for Cobham and the Crematorium. Pass the Crematorium on the left, and just before the next roundabout, take the left turn into River Lane. The field is situated on the right hand side, after Fetcham Park Utd football club.

- CLASS 1     **BRC Walk and Trot Test 1** – combination of horse/rider not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in any dressage test.
- CLASS 2     **Prelim 1**
- CLASS 3     **Prelim 14**
- CLASS 4     **Novice 30**

**Class Entry Fees:** £6.00 per class – Bookham Riding Club Members  
£10.00 per class – Non-members of Bookham Riding Club  
Copies of BRC Walk Trot test available via website, or contact secretary.

All tests are qualifiers for Sunshine Tour 2010.

**Rules & Conditions of Entry**

- Competitions are run in accordance with the BD rules
- All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over
- No entry will be refunded after the closing date except on production of a medical or veterinary certificate
- The judge’s decision is final and any objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and accompanied by a £15.00 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- It is the condition that no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers, their representatives or helpers for any loss or damage to spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends or property under any circumstances whatsoever
- Bookham Riding Club reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without disclosing a reason or to alter, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary
- It is the responsibility of all competitors to present themselves in time for the classes in which they are entered
- Horses must NOT be left tied to vehicles and left unattended
- All dogs *must* be kept on a lead on the show ground at all times
- NO BICYCLES to be ridden on showground
- Prize money and/or rosettes may be withheld if there are insufficient entries in a class
- Protective headgear, properly secured must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SNZ3838 1998. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk. All competitors must wear correct riding dress. Body protectors are recommended
- It is the responsibility of all participants to clear up their rubbish and debris and leave the showground fit for grazing. *Please* do not muck out your horsebox/trailer on the showground

The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.
