

### **RING 1 9.30am Start**

**Class 1** Working Hunter Pony 14.2hh and under. Jumps 70cm

**Class 2** Working Hunter Horse. Jumps 85cm

**Class 3** Working Show Hunter

Open to Cobs, Maxi Cobs, Hacks and Riding Horses, mares and geldings, exceeding 148cm. A course of rustic fences will be jumped. Once all competitors have jumped, you will then be called back into the ring for individual shows and conformation assessment. Stepping back at any obstacle will be counted as a refusal. Jumps not to exceed 80cm.

**Will not start before 1.00pm**

**Class 4** Pony Club Pony/Riding Club Horse. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle and will be required to jump approx 70cm

*Ridden Horse Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 1-4. Sash to winner.*

### **RING 2 9.30am start**

**Class 5** Ridden Coloured

**Class 6** Ridden Mountain and Moorland horse or pony pure/part bred

**Class 7** Ridden Veteran Open to horses and ponies over 16 years of age

**Class 8** Ridden Cob/Cob Type

*Ridden Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 5-8. Sash to winner*

**Will not start before 1.00pm**

**Class 9** Novice Ridden Open to any type/breed. Suitable for anyone new to showing who would like to have a go.

**Class 10** Riding Horse/Hack Open to horses exceeding 148cm. Class may be split if enough entries. Judge will ride.

**Class 11** Ridden show hunter horse/pony (class will be split if enough entries)

**Class 12** Ridden Thoroughbred (ROR and Non ROR registered)

*Ridden Championship for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 9-12. Sash to winner*

**Class 13** Condition and Turnout Ridden or in-hand

**Class 15** Best Junior Rider Aged under 16 years

**Class 16** Family Pony/Horse To be ridden in a snaffle bridle

**Class 17** Prettiest Mare/Handsomest Gelding. Class may be split if sufficient entries

**Class 22** In hand Mountain and Moorland, horse or pony, pure/part bred

**Class 23** Clear round jumping throughout the day. Starting at 60 cm and every hour going up 10 cm. One round £3 or 2 rounds for £5

#### **Rules & Conditions of Entry**

- Competitions are run in accordance with British Riding Club rules
- All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over
- No entry will be refunded after the closing date except on production of a medical or veterinary certificate
- The judge's decision is final and any objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and accompanied by a £15.00 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained
- It is a condition of entry that no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers, their representatives or helpers for any loss or damage to spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends or property under any circumstances whatsoever
- Bookham Riding Club reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without disclosing a reason or to alter, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary
- It is the responsibility of all competitors to present themselves in time for the classes in which they are entered
- Horses must NOT be left tied to unattended vehicles
- All dogs *must* be kept on a lead on the showground at all times
- NO BICYCLES to be ridden on showground
- Prizes and/or rosettes may be withheld if there are insufficient entries in a class
- Protective headgear, properly secured, must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats BSI Kitemark of standard PAS015 (1998 or 2011); SEI mark ASTM F1163 (2004a); SNELL E2001 with official SNELL label and number; SAI Global Mark AS/NZS 3838 (2006). Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk. Full details of acceptable headwear are available at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>
- All competitors must wear correct riding dress. Body protectors are recommended and are compulsory for some events From 1 January 2018, we will not be accepting Beta Level 3 Body Protectors with a 2000 label. All labels will need to be 2009 onwards.
- It is the responsibility of all participants to clear up their rubbish and debris and leave the showground fit for grazing. Please do not muck out your horsebox/trailer on the showground
- **All horses must have up to date valid flu vaccinations which must be available for inspection.**
