Rules & Conditions of Entry

- Competitions are run in accordance with British Riding Club rules
- All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over
- No entry will be refunded after the closing date except on production of a medical or veterinary certificate
- The judge's decision is final and any objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and accompanied by a £15.00 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained
- It is a condition of entry that no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers, their representatives or helpers for any loss or damage to spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends or property under any circumstances whatsoever
- Bookham Riding Club reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without disclosing a reason or to alter, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary
- It is the responsibility of all competitors to present themselves in time for the classes in which they are entered
- Horses must NOT be left tied to unattended vehicles
- All dogs must be kept on a lead on the showground at all times
- NO BICYCLES to be ridden on showground
- Prizes and/or rosettes may be withheld if there are insufficient entries in a class
- Protective headgear, properly secured, must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats BSI Kitemark of standard PAS015 (1998 or 2011); SEI mark ASTM F1163 (2004a); SNELL E2001 with official SNELL label and number; SAI Global Mark AS/NZS 3838 (2006). Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk. Full details of acceptable headwear are available at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>
- All competitors must wear correct riding dress. Body protectors are recommended and are compulsory for some events. From 1 January 2018, we will not be accepting Beta Level 3 Body Protectors with a 2000 label. All labels will need to be 2009 onwards.
- It is the responsibility of all participants to clear up their rubbish and debris and leave the showground fit for grazing. Please do not muck out your horsebox/trailer on the showground
- All horses must have up to date valid flu vaccinations which must be available for inspection.

The organisers of these shows have taken reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.

CHANGE TO CLASS ENTRY AND RULES

Please note we have made a change to class restrictions for 2019

Only 2 show jumping heights can be entered.

Only 2 dressage levels can be entered.

If third level class is entered this will be HC, or if horse / rider are "over qualified", or second rider at same level on same horse.

Restrictions on entries (i.e. can't do 50cm if competing at 80cm; can't do Intro if been placed at Prelim in restricted section etc) are included in schedules. Please check these before entering or note on entry HC if applicable.

QUALIFYING CLASSES

Bookham Riding Club Members' Championship Classes

Dressage – Prelim / Novice. All members placed 1st -7th throughout the year qualify for the Championship Show Jumping – 70cm/80cm/90cm/100cm. All members placed 1st -7th or jumping double clear throughout the year qualify for the Championship



Sunshine Tour Qualifiers. The Sunshine Tour National Championship is held on the 'hallowed turf' of The All England Showground at Hickstead from 12-15 September 2019 for unaffiliated and amateur competitors of all ages and abilities.

The Championships features: Dressage from intro to Elementary; Show jumping from 30cm to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more; Eventers Challenge from 60cm through to 1m.

Retraining of Racehorse Riding Club Challenge

ADDITIONAL SANDS FARM HEALTH AND SAFETY:

- Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside boxes/trailers (or to any fencing) and left unattended.
- Boxes and trailer are not to be mucked out or rubbish left in the lorry or car parking areas. **Droppings can be placed tidily on the Sands Farm EC muck heap.**
- Dogs, **DRONES**, bicycles, roller blades or similar are not permitted on the Showground or the car parking area. **Dogs must be confined to the owner's vehicle** and kept on a lead in the lorry parking area. Dog mess is to be cleared up and poo bags taken home. **POO BAGS ARE NOT TO BE LEFT AROUND OR HUNG ON TREES OR FENCES**
- No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping or dressage competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury**
- Any horse/pony that has been in contact with any infectious disease should not attend any shows, clinics, etc. at this Centre.
